A prominent and prolific Italian writer, Natalia Ginzburg (1916-1991) is known for her novels, plays, short stories, and essays. This collection brings together, for an English-speaking audience, a variety of critical perspectives on Ginzburg's work. The essays, all by North American scholars, examine the author's entire production. The topics examined include Ginzburg's struggle to define herself as a woman, a writer, and an intellectual; her interpretation of the relationship between historical events and private lives; her reflections on the women's movement and the changing nature of the family; and her mastery of a distinctly personal writing style. What emerges here is a nuanced and complex portrait of Ginzburg and her work. The reader is given a sense of the importance of her contribution, not only as a writer but as a witness to the events of the twentieth century. The volume also includes a chronology, a bibliography, and translations of some of Ginzburg's lesser-known writings, including three articles, a poem, and a one-act play.

In 1981 Federico, a 36-year old Italian tour escort of a group of Italian students in Ireland, meets Blanche, a 21-year old au-pair girl from France. He is a radio disc jockey and also a teacher of English. They decide to meet again two months later and make love. In the meantime he accompanies his group to London and then he goes to New Jersey for one month with another group. He meets Blanche in France and then in Italy. The title comes from the car number plates of Ireland, Italy and France. The original book is written in English and Italian, with some parts also in French, and is a good opportunity for those who want to study Italian and English.

What role did Dante play in the work of Pier Paolo Pasolini (1922-1975)? His unfinished and fragmented imitation of the Comedia,

La Divina Mimesis, is only one outward sign of what was a sustained dialogue with Dante on representation begun in the early 1950s. During this period, the philologists Gianfranco Contini (1912-1990) and Erich Auerbach (1892-1957) played a crucial role in Pasolini's re-thinking of 'represented reality', suggesting Dante as the best literary, authorial and political model for a generation of postwar Italian writers. This emerged first as 'Dantean realism' in Pasolini's prose and poetry, after Contini's interpretation of Dante and of his plurilingualism, and then as 'figural realism' in his cinema, after Auerbach's concepts of Dante's figura and 'mingling of styles'. Following the evolution of Pasolini's mimetic ideal from these formative influences through to La Divina Mimesis, Emanuela Patti explores Pasolini's politics of representation in relation to the 'national-popular', the 'questione della lingua' and the Italian post-war debates on neorealism, while also providing a new interpretation of some of his major literary and cinematic works.

Il presidente muore ammazzato, poi ne muore un secondo, la criminalità fa il paio con una fortissima crisi economica e sociale serpeggia una violenza alla Arancia Meccanica. Anche le amichette della scuola (privata) voltano la faccia a Lola quando i genitori sono costretti a trasferirsi in un quartiere popolare per mancanza di denaro. Pian piano Lola si trova a giocare a fare la dura e a entrare in gang di quartiere al femminile. L'amore per Iz, ragazza nera spigliata e combattiva, la trascina sempre più a fondo e ogni sera il coprifuoco viene anticipato... Un mondo distopico come un romanzo di Philip K. Dick che, come nella migliore letteratura fantascientifica assomiglia moltissimo al nostro, funestato dalla crisi. Piccoli elementi sempre più determinanti dipingono una situazione di violenza che non risparmia i bambini, neppure quelli delle "buone famiglie".
